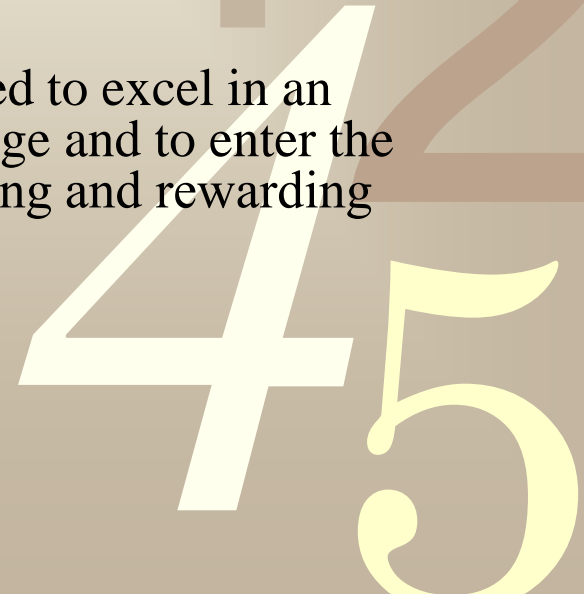

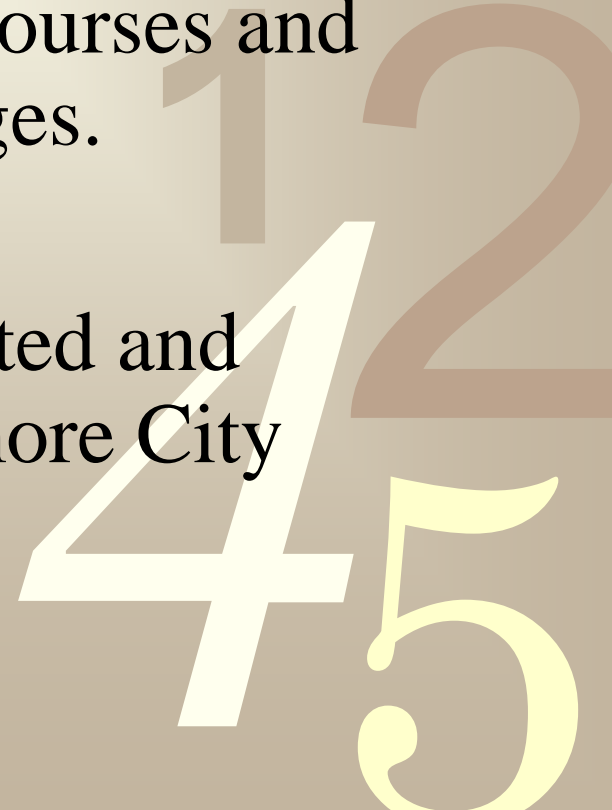

- Recruitment focuses on motivated and academically-promising Baltimore City public middle school students.

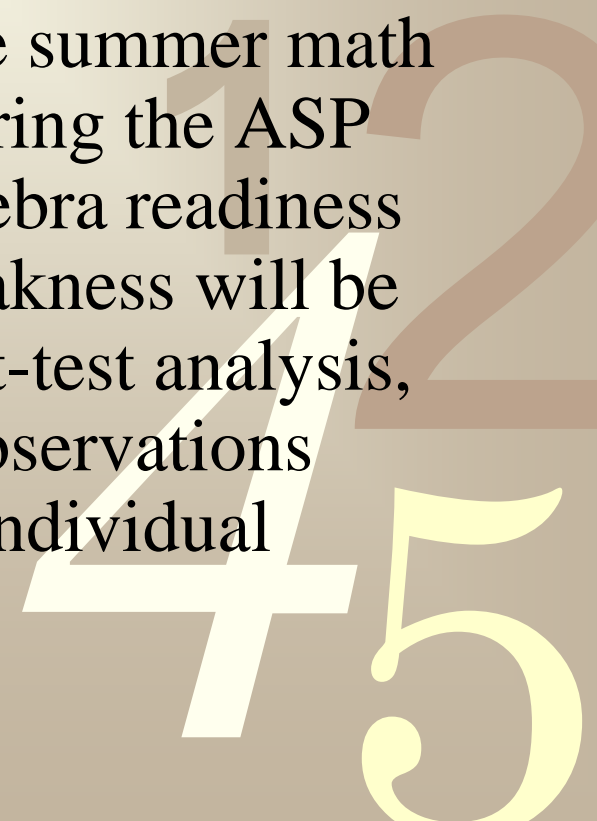
